2. What should be done, if anything, at the federal level to reduce our use and dependence on fossil fuels? (75-word limit)

There is too much federal legislation, so encourage research work to be done to find alternatives to dependence on fossil fuels. Also encourage drilling for new fuels.

3. What should be our short term and long-term goals in Iraq and the rest of the Middle East? (75-word limit)

Short-term goal: Teach Iraqis “how to” defend themselves.

Long-term goal: Prepare for withdrawal of US troops.

Goal in Middle East: back up our allies.

4. What should the federal government do, if anything to ensure that every American has health coverage? (75-word limit)

1st Plan for basic healthcare/pharmacy coverage for every American citizen.

2nd When people leave a job, an option of \$10/mo healthcare coverage for the next year should be given with federal funds in place of what the job had covered previously. If no coverage was in place then no further option extended to the employee who voluntarily left their job.

5. What should the federal government do about immigration? (75-word limit)

1st Allow time for opportunities for immigrants who are already in the US to register to be considered for green card status for work in the US.

2nd Current US laws need to apply to people in the US whether citizens or immigrants unless otherwise stated.

3rd Stop inhumane treatment of potential immigrants, or who are currently detainees, or POWs.

6. Do you favor any changes in federal laws protecting water quality, air quality, the landscape, endangered species or laws to reduce global warming? (75-word limit)

Too much federal legislation is occurring re: environmental issues. Instead, encourage research by businesses with tax break incentives to find successful changes to these areas.
